## Sunbury Referees Rules Exam 2009

Questions that use Sunbury team names refer to the Sunbury By-Laws.

All questions are true or false; mark the answer on the answer sheet. Please ensure that all details are completed on the Answer sheet.

Exam is to be completed by 27<sup>th</sup> June 2009. They can be handed to me or placed in the referee advisors box at the stadium.

1. A4 receives a pass and is closely guarded by B5. A4 throws the ball over the head of B5, runs around him, and whilst the ball is still airborne, bats the ball to the floor with one hand and continues to dribble. This is legal play.
2. A Saint's team turns up just as the referee signals for the game to start, to avoid any delay the referees start the game clock while the scorer fills out the sheet. This is the correct procedure.
3. A Dodger's team introduce a new player into the team during week 10 of the season, the player only has black shorts, the new player may play in the black shorts and has three weeks to get correct shorts.
4. "A" team is running a full court press in defence. A4 in his forward court, jumps to intercept a pass, catches the ball then lands in his back court. This is legal play.
5. The game has entered the last two minutes of the fourth period when defensive player A4 commits a goal tending violation. Two points are awarded to "B" team. The coach of "A" team requests a substitution. It shall be granted.
6. A4 is dribbling the ball when he falls to the floor accidentally and his momentum causes him to slide two metres. This is a travelling violation by A4.
7. A4 steals the ball in his backcourt and breaks for the basket. There is no opponent between him and the basket. B5 chases A4 and attempts to play the ball from a position behind A4 and makes contact which is not heavy and is judged to be a foul. This foul shall be charged as unsportsmanlike.
8. The coach of the team is responsible for designating the shooter for free throws resulting from non-contact fouls.
9. Dribbler A4 is straddling the centre line and dribbling the ball in the forward court. This is a ball returned to back court violation by A4.
10. Dribbler A4 is straddling the centre line and dribbling the ball in the forward court nine seconds have passed since "A" team gained control of the ball in the back court. The referee calls an eight second violation. The call is correct.
11. A4 is out of bounds with the ball preparing to make a throw-in. Before he can release the ball, B5 fouls A5. The foul shall be charged as unsportsmanlike.

12. Dribbler A4 completes his dribble straddling the centre line. He then passes the ball to A5 who is his backcourt. This is legal play.
13. At the beginning of the fourth quarter, both teams attack and defend in the wrong direction and the attacking team scores a field basket. The basket shall count and both teams shall continue to play in the "wrong" direction for the remaining time in the fourth quarter.
14. A4 is dribbling the ball from his back court, straddles the centre line whilst dribbling the ball in the front court. A4 then continues to dribble and returns entirely to the back court. This is legal play.
15. The referee tosses the ball on the jump ball at the beginning of the game. The ball is legally tapped by jumper A4 and immediately after, a held ball is called between A5 and B5. A jump ball will take place at the centre circle between A5 and B5.
16. After calling a three second on A4, The trail official hands the ball to a B team player for a throw in, on the side line opposite the scorers table , a the free throw line extended. This is correct.
17. During the last two minutes of the game, A4 has dribbled for six seconds in the team "A" backcourt, when B4 taps the ball out-of-bounds. Team "A" is granted a time-out. After the time-out, the game is resumed with a throw-in from the centre line extended, opposite the scorer's table. If A4 passes the ball into his back court, "A" team shall have only two seconds to advance the ball to their front court.
18. A4 is closely defended and in order to improve his court position, he deliberately throws the ball against the backboard and attempts to catch the rebounding ball. The ball ricochets off the hand of A4 and it falls to the floor. A4 is first to the ball and begins a dribble. This is legal play.
19. Team "A" has been in control of the ball for five seconds in the team "A" back court when a held ball occurs. The officials determine that team "A" is entitled to the next alternating possession throw-in. Team "A" shall have a new eight seconds to advance the ball to their front court. (T for yes, F for no)
20. Superoos coach requests a time out with 50 seconds to go in the first half. The request should be denied.
21. On the jump ball that begins the first period, the ball has been legally tapped when non-jumper A4 jumps from team A's front court, gains control of the ball while airborne and lands straddling the centre line. This is a violation by A4.
22. A4 in his team's front court, in the corner outside the three point line, passes towards A5 who is positioned in the opposite corner of the court. As the ball passes over the basket, B5 jumps and puts his arm up through the basket and bats the ball away. This is three points to A4.
23. A4 is a player-coach. During an interval of play, A4 is charged with a technical foul for abuse of an official. The technical foul shall be recorded against A4 as a player and not as a coach

24. A4 attempts a jump shot for a field goal. While the ball is in the air, the twenty-four second device signal sounds. After the signal, but with A4 still in the air, B4 commits an unsportsmanlike foul on A4 and the ball misses the ring, this is a twenty-four second violation and the foul shall be ignored.
25. A Braves player has a new pierced eye stud that cannot be taken out. The Braves player is allowed to take the court as long as the stud is taped over.
26. A4 jumps to shoot. B5 places his hands on the ball forcing it loose from the hands of A4. A4 still in mid air regains possession of the ball, returns to the floor and dribbles. This is legal play by A4.
27. In a rebounding contest, A4 strikes the ball with a closed fist. B5 gets a hand to the ball and it goes out-of-bounds. This is a violation by A4 and the ball should be awarded to "B" team out-of-bounds.
28. Team control ends upon release of any free throw.
29. A4 is in a rebounding contest and taps the ball with one hand towards the opponent's basket in an attempt to score. B5, also in the rebounding contest, strikes the arm of A4 whilst the ball is still in contact with the hand of A4. The attempt misses. A foul shall be charged to B5 and two free throws awarded to A4.
30. A4 receives a pass while stationary in his back-court. He passes to A5 who is straddling the centre line. A5 begins dribbling the ball in the back court and returns entirely to the back court. This is legal play.
31. A4 is fouled in the act of shooting simultaneously with the sounding of the game clock signal. A4 is awarded two free throws and then the referee calls a technical foul on the coach of "B" team. A further two free throws should be awarded to "A" team.
32. Only a substitute (player) has the right to request a substitution.
33. The opponents of the free throw shooter shall not distract him by their actions. To do so is a violation.
34. On the opening jump ball of the game, jumper A4 legally taps the ball which falls to the floor inside the jump circle. A4 takes possession of the ball and commences a dribble. This is a violation by A4.
35. After a time out, the ball is handed to A4 for a throw-in. "A" team moves the ball down the court and scores a field basket. It is then discovered that the ball should have been given to "B" team for a throw-in after the completion of the time out. This is a correctable error.
36. In normal play, the free throw shooter is the only player who can cause a successful free throw to be cancelled.
37. A4 receives a pass from A5 with one foot touching the floor. A4 then jumps off that foot and lands on both feet simultaneously. A4 then lifts one foot and then releases the ball to commence a dribble. This is legal play.
38. In two person officiating, the lead referee has the primary responsibility for out-of-bounds calls in area three.

39. A4 is charged with an unsportsmanlike foul. B6 is then charged with a player technical foul. "B" team shall be awarded the ball for a throw-in.
40. A jump ball is called "A" team is awarded the ball as a result of the possession arrow. Before the ball is released on the throw-in by A4, A6 is charged with an unsportsmanlike foul. "B" team shall have the next possession arrow.
41. Team "A" has control of the ball with twelve seconds remaining on the "shot clock" when a fight erupts between players of both teams. The officials disqualify all players involved and the ball is awarded out-of-bounds at the centre line extended to "A" team. The "shot clock" shall be reset to twenty four seconds.
42. A4 is in the act of shooting but the ball has not yet left the hand(s) of A4 when B5 is called for a foul off the ball on A6. It is the fifth team foul for the quarter For "B" team. A4's shot is successful. The basket for A4 should count and two free throws awarded to A6.
43. Scores are still tied at the end of the first extra period. The teams shall change baskets for the second extra period.
44. During a throw-in, A4 steps onto the playing court with one foot but returns that foot out of court before releasing the throw-in. This is legal play.
45. Dribbler A4 comes to a legal stop. B5 reaches out and gets a hand to the ball while A4 is holding it. A4 maintains control of the ball and commences another dribble. This is legal play.
46. Any player who commits two technical fouls must be disqualified from the game.
47. The assistant coach has the right by rule to request a time-out.
48. A4 releases a shot for a field goal and while the shot is airborne, A4 is fouled by B4 in the act of shooting. The ball strikes the ring and rebounds above it when B6 jumps and bats the ball away to prevent a score. This is a violation by B6 and the score shall count and a further one free throw awarded to A4.
49. When guarding a player who controls the ball (is holding or dribbling), the elements of time and distance do not apply.
50. A4 has been in the team "B" restricted area for two seconds when he releases a shot for goal. The ball strikes the backboard but does not touch the basket rim and the rebounds to A4 who is still within the restricted area. A4 gains immediate control of the ball and pivots in the direction of the basket to release a new shot for goal. A4 shall be called for a three second violation.
